## Important Information

**Please read the following information carefully. By submitting a Registration Form, you acknowledge that you have read these policies and agree to abide by them.**

1. Registration for Summer Camp is available on a first come, first served basis, with priority consideration for current BeanTree Families. **Currently enrolled families will have until Friday, March 13th to submit their registration forms.** Other families will be put on a waitlist in the order the form is received. After March 13th, we will be awarding spaces from the waitlist.
2. When reserving your child's space, complete the Registration Form and return it to the Front Desk, along with a nonrefundable deposit of \$100 for each week of enrollment. If your child is not currently enrolled as a Beyond the Bell! or Holiday camp student, or if your child did not attend Summer Camp last summer, a Registration Fee of \$125 is also due at the time of registration.
3. Payment for all confirmed weeks of camp enrollment is due in full by 7:00 pm on April 1, 2020. Changes to your child's enrollment can be made at any point prior to April 1st with no penalty. From April 2nd – May 31st, cancellation of any weeks of enrollment will incur a 50% Cancellation Fee. Beginning June 1, 2020, **no refunds will be issued for cancellations.** Registrations received beginning April 2, 2020, must be accompanied by full payment.
4. A completed BeanTree Learning Enrollment Packet, including an updated health form, immunization record, and other important enrollment information must be completed in order for your child to attend. If your child is not currently enrolled, a BeanTree Learning Registration Form is required in addition to a Summer Camp Registration Form.
5. BeanTree Learning carries a Student Accident Policy covering all enrolled students while they are attending BeanTree or are participating in an off-site field trip. Should your child be involved in an accident and you wish to file a claim under the Student Accident policy, please see a Director for more information.
6. Children enrolled in Adventure Camp should arrive no earlier than 6:30 a.m. and must be picked up no later than 7:00 p.m. Children enrolled in In-House Summer Camp should arrive no earlier than 9:00 a.m. (unless enrolled in Before Camp) and must be picked up no later than 3:15 p.m. (unless enrolled in After Camp).
7. All food is included in tuition. This includes breakfast, lunch, and three snacks per day for Adventure Camp. In-House Camp will receive morning and afternoon snack and lunch.
8. Please label all clothing and other personal items with your child's name to ensure complete identification of all items. Please do not allow your child to bring anything of value, such as jewelry or large amounts of money. BeanTree Learning is not responsible for any lost items.
9. A BeanTree Learning Summer Camp shirt is required for each Adventure Camp child attending a field trip. Children not dressed in a Summer Camp shirt when it is required will be provided one and the cost will be added to your BeanTree Learning statement. In-House campers are not required to wear a BeanTree shirt.
10. BeanTree Learning reserves the right to cancel any program if unforeseen circumstances occur or for insufficient enrollment. All money will be refunded on a prorated basis.
11. BeanTree Learning reserves the right to use pictures of your child involved in camp activities for marketing purposes.
12. BeanTree Learning is completely nut-free. Please do not bring items with nuts or nut by-products into the school at any time. This is to create the safest environment possible for children with life-threatening allergies to nuts.
